
## **Meet the keynote speakers...**



**Ambassador Agnes Oswaha** is Head of Mission at the Embassy of the Republic of South Sudan in London. She has previously represented South Sudan at the United Nations and served at the South Sudan Embassy in Washington, DC.



**Hon. Pia Philip** is the Undersecretary (i.e. most senior civil servant) in the Ministry of Peacebuilding, and was a founding trustee of Ibba Girls' Boarding School. He previously served for eight years as Minister for Education for Western Equatoria State.



**Archbishop Samuel Peni** of the Episcopal Church of South Sudan in Western Equatoria State (where Ibba Girls' School is located) is a courageous advocate for peace and reconciliation. Last year, he was co-opted as a trustee and governor of the school and played a key role in recruiting the new headteacher and senior staff.

A buffet lunch will be available from 1:00pm, and the speakers will be introduced at 2:00pm. Speaker contributions will be followed by Q&A, discussion, and a drinks reception from 5:00pm to 6:00pm.
