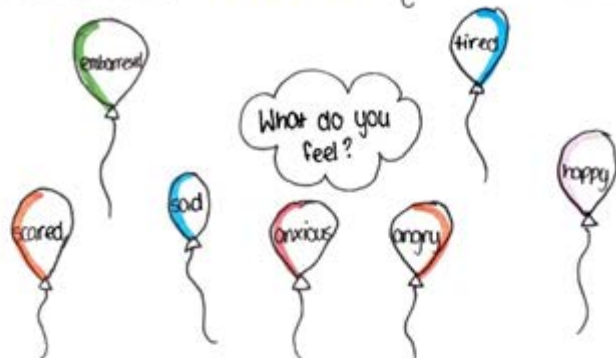


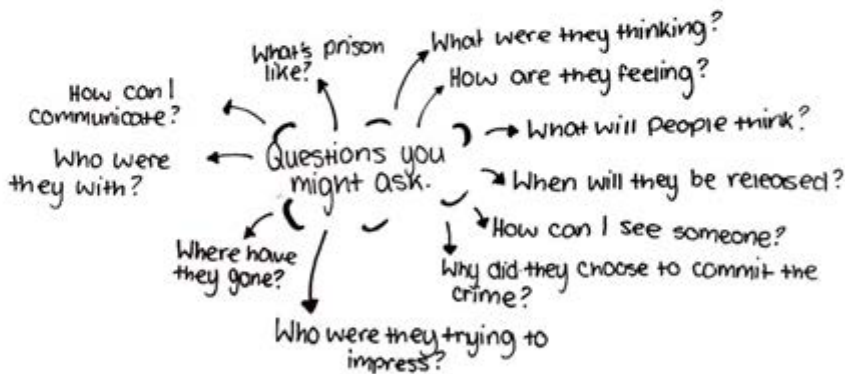
teenagers with 1 Parent in PRISON
